ALBERT HANDELL, JUROR

Albert Handell is one of America's best known and respected artists. He and his wife, Anita Louise West, live in Santa Fe, NM and are co-authors of "Painting the Landscape in Pastel". They do many workshops each year throughout the nation and beyond and he is one of the most respected Jurors for shows. He works in both oil and pastel. He has had a great number of one-man shows in New York and other major cities and has been represented in the Ventana Gallery in Santa Fe for many years. He was elected to the Pastel Society of America Hall of Fame.

2007 CALENDAR

- September 15th - Slide Entry Deadline (postmarked or delivered)
- October 3 - Acceptance Notifications mailed
- October 23 - Deadline for shipped entries
- October 24 – Hand-delivered entries accepted from 2:00 - 5:00 p.m.
- November 1 - Show opens.
- November 8 - 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. Opening Reception and Award Ceremony (Juror will be present).
- December 2 - Show closes.
- December 4 - 2:00 - 5:00 p.m. Pick up hand delivered entries
- December 4-7 - Shipped entries returned if not sold.

SALES

- All entries must be for sale. APS will retain 20% of any and all sales. If an entry is sold between acceptance and opening of the show, it must be withdrawn from the show. Entry fee will not be refunded.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all artists over the age of 18.
- Entries must be at least 80% soft or oil pastel.
- Entries must be original, unpublished and executed within the last three years.
- Paintings that have won awards in previous national exhibitions are not eligible.
- Student work produced under supervision is not eligible.
- Accepted works may be refused if slide does not accurately represent work.
- APS's Exhibition Committee reserves the right to refuse any work submitted.
- Entries must be suitably framed under glass or Plexiglas and ready to hang with wire hangers (sawtooth hangers are not allowed).
- Framed works – the glass or Plexiglas size may not exceed a combined height and width of 76" (example: 22" x 28"=50" or 22" x 36"= 58").
- All accepted works must remain hanging for the duration of the exhibit.

ENTRY

- Artist may submit up to three (3) pieces of work.
- Works will be juried by 2" x 2" 35 mm slide (no glass mounts or tape, please).
- Label front of slides as indicated.
- Slides should be placed in protective sleeves.
- Entry must be accompanied by #10 SASE envelope for juror notification and return of slides. Send to:

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF ACCEPTED ENTRIES

- Shipped entries must be received between October 14th and October 23rd.
- Shipped entries should be sent prepaid in reusable crates with a PREPAID RETURN shipping label.
- Insure for your own protection.
- Shipping instructions, including handling fees and return shipping information, will be sent upon notification of acceptance.
- Shipped entries will be packaged and returned no later than December 7th.
- Pick up hand-delivered entries December 4th between 2 and 5 p.m.

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

Artwork and slides will be handled with all possible care. However, neither the Arkansas Pastel Society, Arkansas Art Center, nor any member of APS will be held responsible for any loss or damage.

APS recommends that Plexiglas be used, especially for works that will be shipped. Glass is used at artist's risk. Artists will be responsible for replacing broken glass. Entering this exhibition shall constitute understanding and agreement on the part of the artist with the conditions stated.

APS suggests that artists carry separate insurance. Permission to reproduce artist's work for publicity purposes is assumed with acceptance.
