JUROR

David Mudrinich lives in Pope County Arkansas and is an Associate Professor in the Department of Art at Arkansas Tech University. He works in a variety of drawing and painting media, focusing currently on the Ozark-Arkansas River Valley and the Mid-South. His formal schooling includes a BS degree from Penn State University and a MFA from the University of Georgia. He has exhibited regionally and nationally including shows at the Arkansas Art Center; Clinton Presidential Center, Little Rock; Butler Institute of American Art, OH; Schenectady Museum, NY; Museum of Arts & Sciences, Macon, GA; Georgia Southern University; University of Georgia; Wichita Center for the Arts and the Springfield Art Museum, MO.

Awards include the ATU Faculty Award for Excellence in Creative Scholarship. Exhibition awards include the UCA Baum Gallery, AR; Springfield Art Museum, MO; Wichita Center for the Arts, KS; Fort Smith Art Center, AR; Chattahoochee Valley Art Museum, GA.

Collections of his work include the State of Georgia Permanent Collection, William J. Clinton Foundation; Hendrix College, AR; Athens-Clarke County Courthouse, GA; North Georgia College; University of Georgia School of Forest Resources; St. Mary's Hospital, GA; St. Frances Cabrini Hospital, LA; Arts & Science Center, Pine Bluff, AR and the Parkersburg Art Center, WV; and numerous private collections.

- August 5th - Digital Entry Deadline (postmarked or delivered)
- September 2 - Acceptance Notifications mailed
- September 24 - Deadline for shipped entries
- October 1 – Hand-delivered entries accepted from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm.
- October 1 - Show opens.
- October 2 - 6:00 - 7:30 p.m. Opening Reception and Award Ceremony (Juror will be present). October 29 - Show closes.
- October 29 - 12:00 - 5:00 p.m. Pick up hand delivered entries
- November 5 - Shipped entries returned if not sold.

SALES

- All entries must be for sale. Sale price listed on entry form cannot be changed. Thea Foundation will retain 20% of any and all sales. If an entry is sold between acceptance and opening of the show, it must be withdrawn from the show. Entry fee will not be refunded.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to current members of APS.
- Entries must be at least 80% soft or oil pastel.
- Entries must be original, unpublished and executed within the last three years. Work which has received awards in any regional or national shows is not eligible.
- Works produced in a class, workshop, or under another artist's supervision are not eligible. Images from internet or copyrighted materials may not be used as source.
- Accepted works may be refused if digital image does not accurately represent work.
- APS reserves the right to refuse any work submitted.
- Entries must be suitably framed under glass or Plexiglas and ready to hang with wire hangers (NO SAWTOOTH Hangers).
- Incomplete entry forms or improperly marked CDs will be disqualified.
- All accepted works must remain hanging for the duration of the exhibit.

ENTRY

- Artist may submit up to three (3) pieces of work. \$25.00 for 2 (two) images and \$30.00 for 3 (three) images.
- Works will be juried by digital images.
- File format must be .jpg. Only images entered should be on CD. Individual file size should be between 300kb and 5 mg. Resolution should be 300 dpi. The file name should be artist's last name_first initial_entry number (ex: davis_r_1). Label CD with name and e-mail address. CD's will not be returned.
- Each CD must be accompanied by a completed entry form and entry fee.

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF ACCEPTED ENTRIES

- Shipped entries must be received between September 6 through September 24.
- Shipped entries should be sent prepaid in reusable crates with a PREPAID RETURN shipping label.
- Insure for your own protection.
- Shipping instructions, including handling fees and return shipping information, will be sent upon notification of acceptance.
- Shipped entries will be packaged and returned no later than November 5.
- Pick up hand-delivered entries October 29 - 12:00 - 5:00 p.m

LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

Artwork will be handled with all possible care. The Arkansas Pastel Society, Thea Foundation, or any member of APS will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

APS recommends that Plexiglas be used, especially for works that will be shipped. Glass is used at artist's risk. Artists will be responsible for repairs of artwork damaged in shipping (Ex.: broken glass, scratched plexiglass, excessive pastel dust or dirty mat). When the painting is received, the artist will be contacted with the price of repairs. If artist does not wish to repair the painting it may be withdrawn from show. Entry fee will not be returned. Entering this exhibition shall constitute understanding and agreement on the part of the artist with the conditions stated.

APS suggests that artists carry separate insurance. Permission to reproduce artist's work for publicity purposes is assumed with acceptance.
